



2008 ISOE International ALARA Symposium Tsuruga Japan, 13-14 November, 2008

First Announcement and Call for Papers

Organization and Host

The 2008 ISOE International ALARA Symposium will be held **13-14 November, 2008 in Tsuruga, Japan**, organized and hosted by the ISOE Asian Technical Center (ATC) and JNES, and co-sponsored by the OECD Nuclear Energy Agency (NEA) and the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA).

Background

The Information System on Occupational Exposure (ISOE) provides a forum for radiation protection experts from utilities and national regulatory authorities to discuss, promote and co-ordinate international co-operative undertakings for the radiological protection of workers at nuclear power plants. Direct interaction between radiation protection professionals remains an important component of information exchange within the ISOE program, as demonstrated by the international and regional ISOE ALARA Symposia on occupational exposure management at nuclear power plants. Organized by the technical centers, the objective of these open symposia is to provide a forum for radiation protection professionals from the nuclear industry and regulatory authorities to exchange practical information and experience on occupational exposure issues in nuclear power plants to improve the optimization of worker radiological protection.

Scope

The 2008 ISOE International ALARA Symposium will cover operational, scientific and strategic/policy developments in the field of occupational radiological protection, such as:

- Source Term Reduction Technologies
- Radiological Work Management
- Industry ALARA/RP Experiences, including Experience with ISOE in Occupational Radiation Protection
- Advanced Technology: (Remote Monitoring, 3D Simulation, Robotics ...)

Language

The working language will be English.

Participants

Participation is open to all radiological protection experts and all those concerned with occupational radiological protection, including NPP owners and operators, NPP designers, industry associations, regulatory authorities and their technical support organizations, research organizations, and observers from OECD NEA and IAEA member countries

Call for Papers

Participants wishing to provide presentations in the Symposium are requested to submit an abstract of 150-250 word with the registration form.

Symposium Date and Location

The symposium will take place from 13-14 November, 2008 at **Plaza Bansho** hall in **Tsuruga, Japan**. A technical tour to a nuclear power plant is scheduled prior to the Symposium, on the afternoon of November 12, 2008.

The symposium will be held immediately following the 2008 ISOE Management Board meeting in Kyoto. ISOE members may participate to the Management Board meeting as an official representative of their

country (utility or regulatory authority representative) or as an observer.

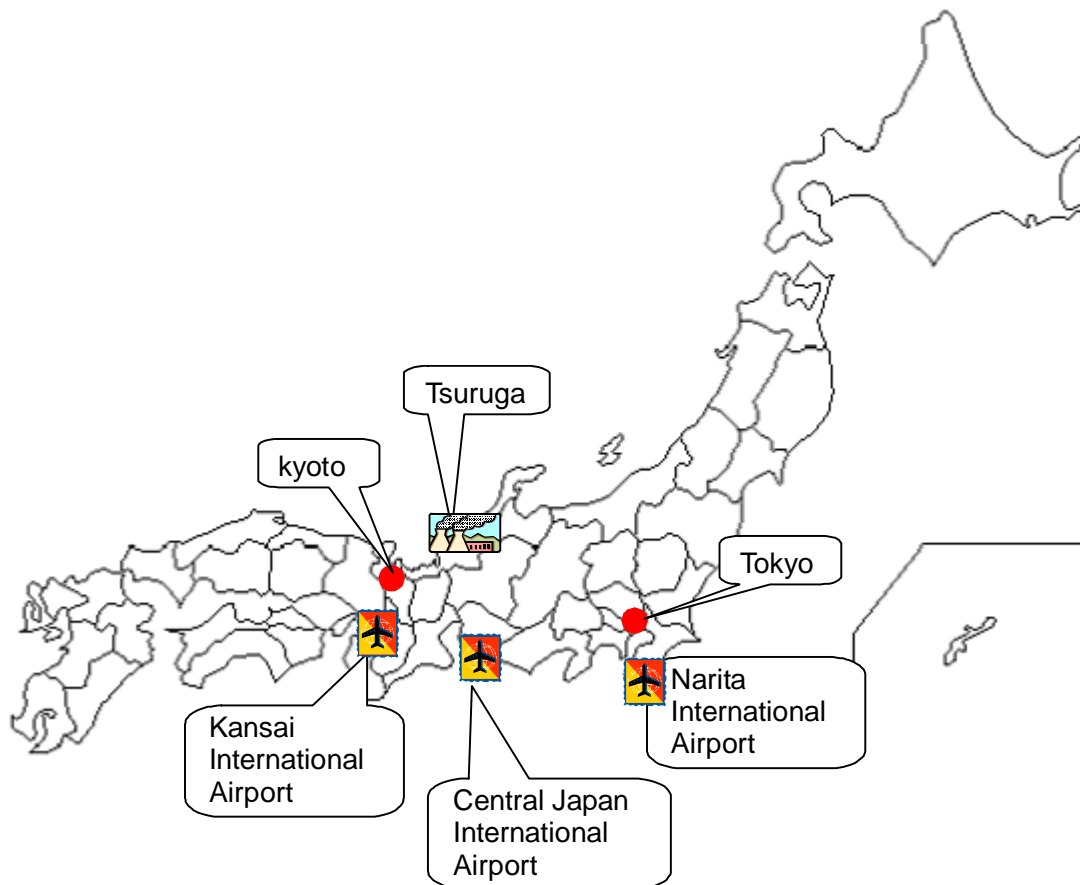
